The Scholarship Program

Par Mar Stores is proud to offer a scholarship program designed to assist students in our communities. Par Mar Stores provides multiple scholarships to high school seniors or graduates and college undergraduates enrolled in a full-time course of study at a college or university.

Eligibility

Anyone who resides in Pennsylvania, Ohio, West Virginia or Kentucky is eligible.

Awards

Par Mar Stores will award multiple scholarships for one full year of study. Students may reapply to the program each year they meet eligibility requirements.

Selection of Recipients

Scholarship recipients are selected on the basis of academic record, community involvement, school activities, honors, work experience, statement of career goals and financial need.

Applications

Applications will be received from February 1 through April 30 of each year. Awards will be announced in late May each year.

Selection

Par Mar Stores Scholarship committee will select the recipients.

Payment of Scholarship

Par Mar Stores will pay scholarship awards prior to payment being due to the college or university. Checks will be mailed to the recipient's home address and will be made payable, jointly, to the recipient and the school. The check must be endorsed by both the recipient and the school.

The application may be copied and distributed to students living in Pennsylvania, Ohio, West Virginia or Kentucky.
