For the Ceredo-Kenova Rotary Club CTE Scholarship

- Application should be printed or typed in black ink and delivered to your School Counselor or CTE Administrator.
- Application must be completed in its entirety. Incomplete forms will not be considered.
- If you wish, you may submit further documentation to support your application; i.e. letters of recommendation, copies of awards, etc. These items should be attached to the back of the application.
- All application materials must be received on or before the due date printed on the first page of the application. Applications received past this date will not be considered.
- Applications will be read by the Scholarship Committee. To assure selection is made on merit only, the Committee Chairperson will assign a code to each application and members will not see the names on any applications.
- Only students planning to attend Career Technical Schools, Community Colleges, Jr. Colleges, and etc. will be considered for this scholarship. Students must demonstrate a plan to pursue an area leading to career and skills pathway.
- Recipient is expected to carry a full course of study and maintain a grade average of at least 2.7. A full course of study will be defined by the guidelines of the institution.
- Recipient is expected to communicate with the Rotary Club at the end of the first semester pertaining to grades and accomplishments.
- One (1) \$500.00 non-renewable Career Technical Scholarship will be awarded.
- Funds will be disbursed to the Bursar's office or equivalent of your desired institution; half of the awarded amount per semester.
- At the end of the first semester, proof of GPA and proof of second semester's schedule will be required to receive the 2nd half of the scholarship.
