Committee will use the following criteria to choose a winner:

Academic Advancement.....30%

Need.....30%

Character.....15%

Career Commitment.....15%

Variety of School & Community Involvement.....10%

The student must be sponsored by a West Virginia Garden Club.

Applicant must complete the full application, enclose an official record of high school grades, any letters of recommendation, and write a minimum 250 word typed document. The document should list the applicant's purpose for applying, goals, and any background information, that might help the committee with the above criteria (school activities, community involvement, financial need, personal commitment, etc.) It is not necessary to submit a photograph.
